

Program Hours Requirements for Ayurvedic Health Counselor

- A. Total AHC program hours = 600 hours minimum including didactic and clinical components¹
- B. Total program hours are delivered as follows: (see below for definitions)
 - Residential in-person hours: 180 minimum
 - Distance learning hours: 420 maximum; these hours may be delivered in the following formats:
